

### **Tenure-Track Faculty Positions Civil, Construction, and Environmental Engineering**

The Department of Civil, Construction, and Environmental Engineering (CCEE) at North Carolina State University (NCSU) expects to fill four tenure-track faculty positions; one of which will be the Edward I. Weisiger endowed faculty position in the Construction Engineering and Management (CEM) area.

The department seeks to augment its expertise by inviting applicants who can contribute to the following thrust areas: intelligent infrastructure, energy and the environment, and/or sustainable and resilient built and natural systems; these areas are coincident with the strategic vision of the College of Engineering. Of particular interest are applicants with research plans for integrating multiple areas of the CCEE department to address challenges facing coastal regions. This thrust will focus on the nexus between civil infrastructure systems and coastal sustainability and resilience. The CCEE department has an ongoing relationship with the Coastal Studies Institute (CSI) located in Manteo, NC ([csi.northcarolina.edu](http://csi.northcarolina.edu)). We anticipate some of the new hires to be involved with the CSI and benefit from their new laboratory.

Successful candidates should be able to participate in multidisciplinary initiatives to support the missions of the department and the college. Appointments are expected to be at the assistant professor level, although exceptionally qualified candidates may be considered at higher levels. An earned doctorate degree in civil engineering or a closely related field is required. Professional experience and a professional engineering license are desirable.

Applications in the CEM area will be considered for the Edward I. Weisiger endowed faculty position. Applicants with an established record as full professor can be considered for the title of Edward I. Weisiger Distinguished Professor in CEM. Applicants at the associate professor level can be considered for the time-limited title of Edward I. Weisiger Distinguished Scholar in CEM. Applicants at the assistant professor level can be considered for the time-limited title of Edward I. Weisiger Distinguished Fellow in CEM.

We are seeking colleagues to join a vibrant department with 47 faculty members, over 800 undergraduates and 350 graduate students. The CCEE department has many excellent laboratories and is planning to move to a new building on NCSU's Centennial Campus in the future. We seek candidates who are able to teach undergraduate and graduate courses, collaborate across disciplines, and develop strong externally funded research programs. Review of applications will begin on October 15, 2012, and applications will be accepted until the positions are filled.
