TENURE-TRACK FACULTY POSITION IN STRUCTURAL ENGINEERING

The Department of Civil Engineering at Valparaiso University, located in Valparaiso, Indiana, invites applications for a tenure-track faculty position in the area of structural engineering beginning in August 2014. All areas within the field of structural engineering will be considered; however, preference will be given to candidates with a demonstrated ability to develop an experimental research program that will utilize the structural engineering laboratory located in the Donald V. Fites Engineering Innovation Center.

The successful candidate will be responsible for teaching undergraduate courses, developing a research program that incorporates undergraduate students, and providing service to the department and profession. Teaching responsibilities could include courses in structural engineering, introductory civil engineering courses, the civil engineering capstone design sequence, and introductory general engineering courses. Candidates should have a strong commitment to teaching excellence and have the ability to communicate effectively with students and colleagues. The candidate shall have the legal authority to work in the USA, shall have completed a Ph.D. in civil engineering or closely related discipline, and will obtain their professional engineering license prior to the conclusion of the tenure track period. Preference will be given to candidates with a BSCE from an ABET-accredited institution.

Candidates should be interested in working at a university engaged in issues in Christian higher education in the Lutheran tradition.
