## **Construction Engineering and Management Faculty Position**

Applications are invited for a tenure track position for spring 2015 in the Department of Civil and Construction Engineering at Western Michigan University in the area of construction engineering and management. The position is anticipated to be filled at the assistant professor level. An earned bachelor's degree in civil or construction engineering and an earned doctorate in civil or a closely related field at the time of hiring are required. The successful candidate should be a registered professional engineer or be able to obtain registration within a reasonable time.

The successful candidate will teach undergraduate and graduate courses in his or her area of expertise including introductory service courses, develop new courses, advise graduate and undergraduate students, conduct research relevant to construction engineering and management with particular emphasis on the national infrastructure, supervise master's and doctoral students, and provide service to the university and profession.

Western Michigan University is a Carnegie doctoral research extensive institution serving 24,000 students at its main and branch campuses. Kalamazoo is in a metropolitan area in southwestern Michigan, midway between Chicago and Detroit, with a population of over 320,000. The College of Engineering and Applied Sciences offers 15 bachelor's, 9 master's, and 6 doctoral programs. Among these are a master's degree in civil engineering, a doctoral program in engineering and applied sciences with a focus in civil engineering, an EAC/ABET accredited bachelor's degrees in civil engineering, and an EAC/ABET accredited bachelor's degree in construction engineering. A 270-acre engineering campus opened in summer 2003 includes a new building for the College of Engineering and Applied Sciences as well as a Business Technology and Research Park.
